Presidents Report – Gordy Axel

- Three Rivers Soccer Club is growing.
- Recreation program is growing, feeding into academy program.
- Toyota Sponsorship – sponsoring Labor Day Tournament
- Working with Tri-Cities Sports Council to make Labor Day tournament bigger.
- Striving to keep costs down to provide opportunities for everyone, but within reason for referee, field rental and state fees.
- Biggest limitation is lack of home fields – recently submitted a grant application for a lighted field in Pasco; we are awaiting an answer on that (going rate is ~\$1.5M)

Treasurers Report – Alejandra Reyes

- Financial position remains secure and solid.
- Working closely with an independent accountant to manage financials for club.
- Covered financial report numbers.

Technical Director Report – Jason Quintero

- Number of teams and quality of leagues is at an all-time high.
- 1911 actively rostered players
- Adding new coaches throughout the year – working with high schools and colleges in area to develop coaches.
- Over 150 teams in club – recreational and competitive.
- Continually looking for a place to call home.

Rec Report – Sara & Chip Elfring

- 98 Recreational teams, close to 950 players U5-U210.
- Close to 200 kids sign up between fall and spring.
- In need of more volunteer coaches and more grass space.
